I am writing to support toxicology testing of the fragrance chemical ISO E Super. Recommended use for ISO E Super includes lotions, deodorants, bleach products, fabric softeners, bath products, household cleaners, shampoos and soap. Those products are widely used in our culture and conceivably come in contact with individuals of all ages, including infants. Suggested use level of ISO E Super is up to 10% of fragrance formulas which makes it a major component. Fragrances are implicated in exacerbating symptoms in adults and children with asthma, as well as individuals with chemical sensitivities. ISO E Super is an excellent choice for toxicology testing.
